

Recruit Intake 22 – Frequently Asked Questions

Ser	Question	Answer
1	I am a candidate for Recruit Intake 22. In my father's NPP, his birthplace is in VDC but now it has changed to municipality. Do I need any verification letter or not?	Yes, you need to bring verification letter from Local Gov Office (Woda Karlaya).
2	I have my NPP, Passport, all education certificates and my mother's original NPP but it's been 5 yrs that my father has no contact with us, and I don't have his original citizenship card or photocopy. Will I be registered?	Yes, but you must get a "missing" verification letter from the CDO office.
3	I do not have original SEE certificates. Will photocopies be accepted?	No. But you can obtain copy of the original from related education authorities. Copy of original certificates must be stamped and signed by the issuing authority.
4	My father is an ex Indian army and our permanent address is Palpa but we are migrated to Kathmandu and now my brother's citizenship is from Kathmandu, is he eligible for British recruitment?	No. if someone has migrated and obtained NPP from Kathmandu, Lalitpur and Bhaktapur districts will not be able to register.
5	I lost my Nepali Citizenship Certificate and now I have a copy (PRATILIPi) of it. Can I apply for BA/GC?	Yes, you can apply with your new NPP (PRATILIPi).
6	What dates should be written on the application form and other documents? What is the size of the photo?	Application Form – The date of form completion. Covid-19 Form - Date of registration. Med Fit to Attend Form – Minimum 10 days before isolation. Photo should be Passport Size (35x45mm)
7	How many PRs will be called forward for Regional Selection?	Total 5000 (BA – 3000 and GCSPF - 2000)
8	I just wanted to know whether the child passport is okay, or do I need to make a new adult passport for selection? I had my passport made 5 years ago as a child passport (नाबालक) and its expiration date is 2025.	We do not accept child passport. You must obtain an adult passport to register.
9	Do I need to bring higher education (+12) certificates as additional documents?	It is not mandatory, but you can bring them if you wish.
10	Is BA & GCSPF Math test paper the same? And what should we practice? Shall we practice the model question which is given in the official website?	That is correct. BA and GC Math test papers are same and model question is uploaded on our official website.
11	I am from Kathmandu can I join?	NPP obtained from Kathmandu, Lalitpur and Bhaktapur districts will not be able to register.
12	Do I have to be a certain religion or caste?	No
13	I have passed my SEE in Electrical engineering, where I had to study Maths, English, science, social, electrical engineering, basic electronics, drawing, workshop, computer. Can I apply for British Gurkha army/GCSPF?	Yes, you can. General Academic subjects with additional subjects such as Computer engineering, Electrical engineering, Civil engineering and Agriculture subjects are accepted. Only CTEVT (Council for Technical Education and Vocational Training) certificates are counted as vocational and will not be accepted.
14	In my father's NPP, he has got Bahadur Thapa but in my NPP there is Thapa only. Do I need caste verification certificate in registration process of RI22?	No. Bahadur is just a middle name and middle name can be anything (e.g. Bahadur, Prasad, Bir, Kumar etc) In your case, you do not need to bring caste verification.

		Caste verification is only needed when your caste differs from your father's eg.Thapa and Thapa Magar.
15	What should I do if I have different name and DOB on my NPP and migration certificate?	You must rectify your migration certificate with your original name and date of birth to register.
16	My family migrated to Gorkha from Surkhet on 2058BS and I was born in Gorkha district on 2059BS, but my grandfather got the migration certificate on 2060BS. Will this certificate work?	We will accept, if the original migrated date stated as BS2058 in the migration certificate.
17	I want to apply for RI22. During the registration period, I will only be 17 years and 7 months. Will I be eligible to register?	You must be 18 years old on 1 st Jan 2022 to register. Please visit our website www.army.mod.uk/bgn . It clearly explains the age criteria.
18	What will happen if the Covid-19 situation does not improve. Are you still planning to hold recruit selection this year?	This will depend on Corona Virus pandemic situation. Please visit our website regularly. We will notify changes through our official website and Facebook.
Medical Questions		
19	I have bowed legs, can I join?	If the gap is over 4 cm then no
20	Can I join with grey hair?	Yes, the colour of hair is not important.
21	I have a scar can I join?	If the scar is not on the torso (upper body) then it does not matter. If the scar is on the torso and flat, it may not be a problem, but more there is a high chance that you will not be selected. Scars are at risk of injury caused by military equipment.
22	Are braces allowed during registration?	Braces are allowed during Registration, but not accepted in Regional and Central Selection.
23	One of my teeth is missing and small fillings on two of my teeth. Can I apply for British Army/GCSPF?	We do not accept more than 2 faults. Please read our medical criteria.
24	Does mole inside my eye will cause any medical issues?	You may/may not be accepted. Our medical experts will examine and make an assessment. (If it was there during birth? Does it affect your eye vision? Has it increased in size since birth?) There will be many more checks before you will be accepted.
